

Mounting Instruction proDOME175/240®



The concrete built-in pot <u>proDOME175®</u> and <u>proDOME240®</u> can be used for installation in exposed concrete and plaster by means of three different types of installation (see below).

The **two-part** concrete built-in pot consists of a lid/ring and bottom:







Assembly

- 1. Turn the lid/ring upside down and place it on a stable surface to optimally stake the bottom.
- 2. Turn the bottom upside down and press with your hand (it may require a light bump). Make sure that the lid/ring is completely locked in place in the bottom.





Types of installation for exposed concrete, as well as plaster

- 3.A Mounting on reinforcing bars in the back with wires through the 6 fastening straps
- 3.B Mounting on formwork board in front with a nail through the central hole







Mounting method for plaster

3.C Mounting on formwork board in front with nails through the 6 mounting holes





Cable/Pipe inlet

4. Drill holes at the desired points, depending on the cable/pipe diameter.

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
